Therefore, Dahiwadi College Dahiwadi grab this opportunity and started "KarmveerBhaurao PatilLivelihood Business Incubation Centre"under PPP Mode in 2019. This centre is approved by MSME ministry, government of India under ASPIRE scheme. To conquer the challenges six modules were designed and implemented. This LBI center has capacity to train 720 incubaties per annum.

The Practice-

The traditional mode of education has their own advantages and disadvantages. This mode is providing degree to students but they enable to gain required skill with respect to the job. India have second largest population lead to less opportunities to get jobs. The faster growing industries and agricultural sector needs skilled workforce and this requirement is not fulfilled by the current institutes. Therefore, the new entrant workforce needs such focused modules which helpful during setups of start-ups or in their own agricultural allied business. The modules of LBI centre designed by the experts by keeping this scenario in mind. ThisLBIcentre are helpful in growing skills of small producers, formers, farm workers, ruralyouths, unemployed youths, students, innovative young entrepreneurs and women self-help groups.
